- Setting SMART OH&S objectives for the benefit of our team, clients and other interested parties.
- Fulfil current applicable OH&S legal and other requirements which relate to our work. CLC will exceed the minimum requirements where practicable and possible.
- Implement and maintain processes to eliminate hazards and reduce OH&S risks associated with our work.
- Continual improvement of our IMS by reducing the number of accidents, incidents of ill health and physical losses to the lowest possible level by operating a risk based approach.
- Consultation and participation of all workers, their representatives and contractors through our SHEQ Forum and/or other forms of communication.
- Promote a positive Health and Safety culture by involving workers from all areas of CLC in matters that affect them.

CLC expect all employees and subcontractors to support this policy and to be vigilant against any actions or circumstances that may endanger them, their colleagues, customers or other persons having access to our work locations.
